Only files of the format .txt is allowed.

An example of how the text file is supposed to look like I presented in the picture below.

Explanation of symbols:

S = Numbers (Positive integers, maximum 12 signs)

D = Numbers (Positive decimal or number 0,00, two decimals)

A = Date in following format in numbers: YYYYMMDD

B = Numbers, 1 or 2

P = Six numbers, year (four signs) followed by month (two signs, 01-

O = 10 numbers
