Text file specification for reporting with a structured text file from booking systems for accommodations statistics



Separated by semicolon

Agencies report information on either arrivals and occupied beds or occupied cottages and apartments, average number of days and people per booking.

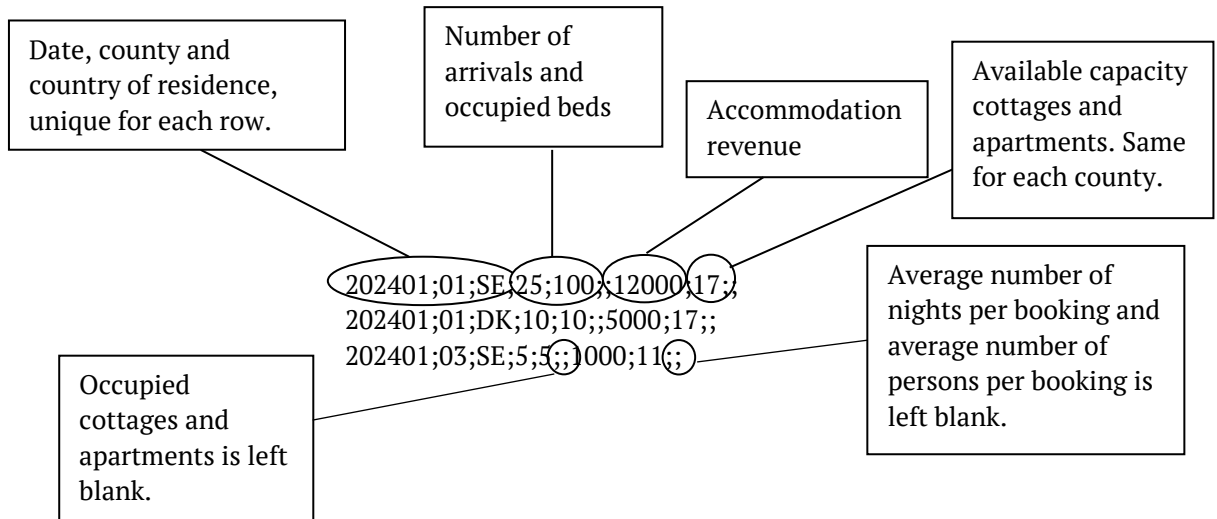

Field name	Field no.	Format	Length	Comments
Date	1	N	6	Use the format YYYYMM, e.g. 202401.
County	2	N	2	The county in which the available cottages and apartments are located, e.g. 01. Counties and municipalities in numerical order (scb.se)
Country of residence	3	T	2	The country in which the guest has lived for the past 12 months or more. The country of residence may be different from the guest's citizenship. Specified by using the international standard ISO 3166- 1:1997, for example FI, SE. Current list available at www.scb.se/inkvartering .
Arrivals	4	N		Distributed per county and country of residence. Can also be referred to as newly registered guests. Only count the arrival of the guest. For example, if four people stay two nights, it counts as four arrivals and eight overnight stays. <i>Agencies reporting occupied cottages and apartments leaves this field empty.</i>
Occupied beds	5	N		Distributed per county and country of residence. Defined as one overnight stay per person. Only report guests visiting for business or leisure. Do not include beds that have been used for asylum accommodation, staff accommodation, social services, owner bookings or similar. <i>Agencies reporting occupied cottages and apartments leaves this field empty.</i>
Occupied cottages and apartments	6	N		Distributed per county and country of residence. A cottage or apartment is occupied when at least one person stays in the room (this also applies to cottages and apartments). Only report guests visiting for business or leisure. Do not include cottages or apartments that have been used for asylum accommodation, staff accommodation, social services, owner bookings or similar.

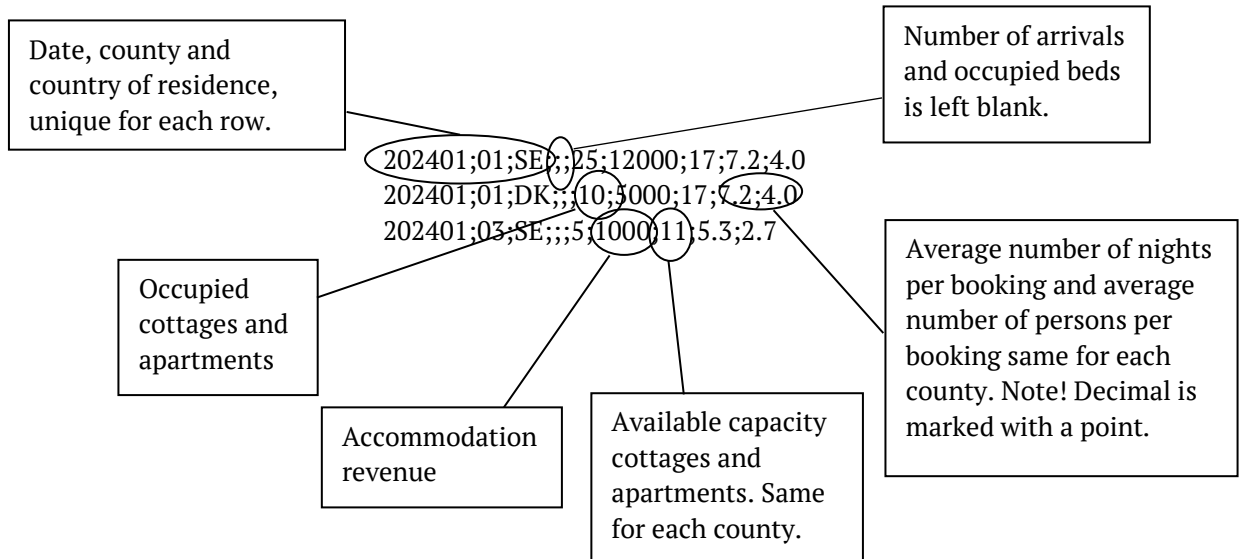

Accommodation revenue of occupied cottages and apartments	7	N		<p>Distributed per county and country of residence.</p> <p>Total for all occupied cottages/apartments, including booking fee and cancellation insurance and excluding VAT. Report in whole Swedish kronor (SEK).</p>
Available capacity cottages and apartments	8	N		<p>Distributed by county.</p> <p>Number of cottages and apartments available for rent during minimum a week for the reporting month, excl. temporarily closed capacity. Only report guests visiting for business or leisure. Rooms and cottages that have been used for asylum accommodation, staff accommodation, social services, owner bookings or similar should not be included in the available capacity.</p>
Average number of nights per booking	9	N		<p>One decimal marked with a point. Used by agencies that report occupied cottages and apartments. Only report guests visiting for business or leisure. Do not include beds that have been used for asylum accommodation, staff accommodation, social services, owner bookings or similar.</p> <p><i>Agencies reporting occupied beds and arrivals leaves this field empty.</i></p>
Average number of persons per booking	10	N		<p>One decimal marked with one point. Used by agencies that report occupied cottages and apartments. Only report guests visiting for business or leisure. Do not include beds that have been used for asylum accommodation, staff accommodation, social services, owner bookings or similar.</p> <p><i>Agencies reporting occupied beds and arrivals leaves this field empty.</i></p>
